Logging in

When you first open the app, you will be greeted by the log in page. Your log in is the exact same as your Online Learning/VLE log in. Your username will be your **Student Code** (3XXXX) and your Password will be your **date of birth in 6-digit format** (unless you have changed this).



Using the App

Once logged in, you can access all your learning materials using the tiles available. Your core resources are coloured **blue** – this includes the **VLE**, **Additional Online Services**, your **Student email**, **e:Vision**, and the **Digital Library**, your **Timetable** – just click the tile for the service that you require. When first using the app, you will need to log in to each service individually.

Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) contains crucial academic information and resources. It is the hub to access your module materials, attend your zoom webinar lectures, submit your assessments, and access various learning resources such as Kortext.
