



Postgraduate Loan 2021/22 application

Postgraduate Loan - Student Finance Guide 2021/22

1) Start by visiting: https://www.gov.uk/student-finance-register-login - click "Start Now" to begin your application.




2) If you have already created an account, please enter in your login details and click "Continue".






3) Once you have entered your login details, you will be directed your online account homepage. Scroll down to the bottom and click "Re-apply or start another application".




4) Click "Higher education" to proceed.






5) Click "Postgraduate" to proceed.




6) Click "Master's" to proceed.






7) It is important that you read the Terms and Conditions before applying the postgraduate loan. Once you have read the terms and Conditions please click "Continue" to proceed.




8) Click "Continue" once you have read the text below.






9) As you are a new student and you will be starting your course in within 2019/20 academic year, click "No" to proceed.




10) Depending on when you are starting your course, please enter the correct date.

May intake – May 2022






11) Select your nationality and click "Continue" to proceed.




12) Select where your permanent residency will be in September 2021 and then click "Continue" to proceed.






13) Please ensure you read the 6 following things before continue with the Postgraduate Master's Loan. Once you have read the 6 following things click "Apply now" to proceed.








15) Please select the answer applicable to you. Then click "Continue" to proceed. Please note if you already hold a postgraduate qualification, you will not be eligible for funding.




16) As you will be studying a full Master's Course, select "Yes" and then "Continue" to proceed.






17) At this stage, you would need to choose the place you wish to study at. Please type in "Anglia Ruskin University" in the text box below.




18) If you are studying a full time course, please click "Full time". If not, click "Part time" if you are studying a part time course.





You can send it off to Student Finance at a later date. If you do not have a valid UK passport you will need to send Student Finance another form of evidence to prove your identity.






21) Please provide your permanent address history. Once completed please select "Continue" to move out to the next section of the application.




